11 English/English 101 & 102	<b>Two</b> five-credit courses must be taken: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ENGL 101 (required) <b>AND</b> one of the following:</li> <li>• CMST 229; CMST&amp; 101, 220</li> <li>• ENGL 102, 235, 247, 248, 249</li> </ul>
3 <sup>rd</sup> Year Mathematics (Alg. 2)	Any <b>one</b> course from the following for 1.0 math credit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Math 98 or 99 (student responsible for tuition)</li> <li>• Math 107, 141, 142, Math&amp;151, Math&amp; 153</li> </ul>
3 <sup>rd</sup> Year Science (algebra-based; typically chemistry)	Any 100 or above Algebra-based chemistry, physics or other science class with lab. Classes must meet college level and be GUR transferrable
US History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• HIST&amp; 137</li> </ul>
World Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1<sup>st</sup> Year 121 Level</li> <li>• 2<sup>nd</sup> Year 122 Level (same language)</li> <li>• *123 Level required by select universities</li> </ul>
<b>Senior Year</b>	
12 English/ English 105	Any <b>two</b> 5-credit courses, 100 level and above, not previously taken, from the following areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ENG 102, 111, 112, 238, 247, 248, 249, 261, 271, 272, 278, 295</li> <li>• HUMANITIES 101, 102, 107, 201</li> <li>• CMST 229; CMST&amp; 101, 220</li> <li>• JOURN 220</li> </ul>
Senior Math/Science	Any 100 or above science course OR Any 100 or above math class that is GUR transferable.
Current World Problems/Civics	Two 5-credit courses from the following areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• POLS 102, 125, 204, 205</li> <li>• POLS&amp; 202, 203</li> <li>• SOC&amp; 201</li> <li>• ECON 101 OR ECON&amp; 202</li> </ul>
World Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2<sup>nd</sup> Year 122 Level (same language as first year credits)</li> <li>• *123 Level required by select universities (recommended; not required)</li> </ul>
MicroApps/Occupational Ed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• BUS 100 OR other approved business, computer, or communications class (see HS counselor)</li> </ul>
Senior Project/ HS Portfolio	ALL students <b>MUST</b> successfully complete a senior project, be enrolled in a sr. portfolio class with WCHS, and complete a junior/senior portfolio.
<b>Other Graduation Requirements needed if not previously met</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Washington State History</li> <li>• Art (2 Credits, or 1 Art &amp; 1 HS &amp; Beyond specific course)</li> <li>• 2 credits Health &amp; Fitness</li> </ul>	Meet with HS Counselor for approved courses
