
Carroll College guarantees admission to students from the Community Colleges of Spokane (CCS) who meet the requirements below. This guarantee does not apply to the Carroll College nursing or education programs; Carroll will accept transfer applications from CCS students, but cannot guarantee admission into the nursing or education programs.

1. At the end of the chosen term CCS students will have successfully completed the requirements to attain an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree from CCS.
2. Other Requirements:
 - i. CCS students must earn a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA in courses required for their major.
 - ii. CCS students must have completed Math 108 – College Algebra or a higher level math course with a minimum grade of “C” prior to enrolling at Carroll College.
 - iii. *If students have not earned the CCS Associate Degree, or if they have not taken ENGL 102 and obtained a grade of “C” or higher they will be required to complete Carroll College English 102 with a minimum grade of “C” in order to obtain a BA/BS from Carroll College.*
 - iv. No more than 2 semester credits (3 quarter credits) of physical education will be considered for the transfer GPA.
 - v. No ESL coursework can be transferred to Carroll, nor will ESL coursework be factored into the transfer GPA.
 - vi. A maximum of 90 lower division transferable quarter units will be accepted for transfer.
 - vii. Students may have additional general education requirements in theology and/or philosophy to fulfill at Carroll College.

Students must certify that the information which they provide to substantiate number (1) above includes any and all courses/units from all postsecondary institutions they have attended, regardless of the country in which the courses were taken.

Carroll College and CCS will work collaboratively to develop a Reverse Transfer agreement for students who did not complete their associate’s degree before transferring to Carroll College. This would allow Carroll College credits to be transferred back to CCS to assist in meeting the student’s associate degree requirements.

Students are aware that this agreement is null and void if it is found that information they provide to Carroll College is not complete or is inaccurate. They must further certify that they do not hold or have not earned a four-year degree from *any* institution of higher learning.
