- An original bank statement verifying funds in the amount of U.S. \$16,500 are available to cover educational and living expenses during attendance.
- An original or certified copy of official transcripts and degree result for high school, GED and colleges attended. (Note: Students who are planning to attend ESL course **ONLY** are not required to submit these documents.) All transcripts must have an English translation. Submit transcripts for all U.S. transferable credits. High school graduation is required for admission to either SFCC or SCC regular academic programs.

**NO TOEFL SCORE IS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION TO EITHER SFCC OR SCC.**

Students may apply to the ESL program at Spokane Falls Community College (SFCC) or Spokane Community College (SCC) without providing a TOEFL score. Students are guaranteed admission to both SFCC and SCC upon successful completion of the ESL program at either SFCC or SCC.

Students applying for admission to the regular academic programs at Spokane Falls Community College (SFCC) or Spokane Community College (SCC) must have a TOEFL score of 61 (IBT), 173 (CBT) or 500 (paper-based). Students may also satisfy the English proficiency requirement with a TOEIC score (610), IELTS (5.0), or Cambridge (grade C).
