Jim Brady has been with Spokane Falls Community College for over 26 years, 16 as mathematics faculty and 10 as an instructional dean. During this time, he has been a strong advocate for improving success in STEM disciplines. Jim was one of a small group of math educators and advocates who in 2003 began Washington's Transition Math Project, a statewide initiative to define common standards for college readiness in mathematics and later led to successful efforts to reform developmental mathematics in Washington community colleges. Jim was a strong advocate for SFCC's planetarium, which serves as a platform for bringing science to the local community as well as supporting Astronomy courses. As a dean, Jim has worked with SFCC's institutional research department and budget manager for a number of years, looking to identify the barriers to success and evaluate the effectiveness of the various strategies that have employed.
