

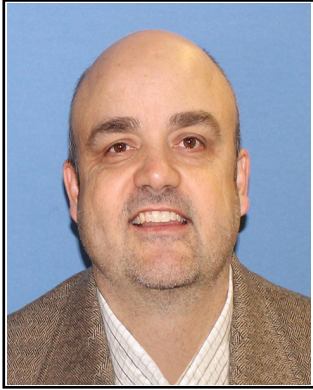

He has been a teacher, a building assistant principal, a principal, a district assessment and evaluation director, and most recent has been serving as Chief Academic Officer and Chief Innovation and Research Officer for Spokane Public Schools.
