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### Notes:

- a. HIST 136 fulfills both the state US History and American Government requirements because of its emphasis on the Constitution.
- b. AA-DTA degree waives Whitworth's Fitness/Wellness requirement. Students transferring without completing the AA will need at least 3 credits of PE, at least one of which must be aerobic. Best transfer courses include PE 100 & 200, 107 & 207, 177 & 277, 184 & 284, 185 & 285, 186 & 286, 187 & 287, and 188 & 288.
- c. AA-DTA degree will waive Whitworth's Fine Arts and Humanities requirements if necessary. Students transferring without the AA-DTA should try to choose a course meeting Whitworth's Fine Arts requirement and one course meeting Whitworth's Humanities requirement. For students pursuing an English Language Arts Area of Concentration, an ENGL course in Group A is recommended as this will complete that state requirement.
- d. Students should choose an elective, based on personal interest, which will count towards their Area of Concentration (see below). This leaves only one course needed for the Area of Concentration.
- e. Together an ECON course and HIST& 214 satisfy state content requirements. The combination of the two is equivalent to a single course at Whitworth.
- f. Any Physical Science except Paleontology.

### Area of Concentration:

- The state requires depth of study in a single academic area. This means Students must complete at least 30 quarter credits in a single area. For AA-DTA transfer students, the most common areas are English Language Arts or Social Studies. These are broad areas.
- English Language Arts includes coursework in CMST, DRMA, ENGL, and JOURN.
  - ENGL &101, CMST& 101, ENGL& 102, and CMST 227 all apply. Only two more courses are needed to complete the Area of Concentration requirement.
  - One of these courses can be satisfied by the elective. The second can come from Drama& 101 or ENGL& 111.
- Social Studies includes ANTH, ECON, GEOG, HIST, POLS, PSYC, and SOC.
  - HIST& 136, the ECON elective course, the Social Science Group A, and HIST 214 all apply. Only two more courses are needed for the Area of Concentration.
  - One of these courses can be satisfied by the elective. For students pursuing a Social Studies Area of Concentration, one course still remains. Consider taking one additional course at SCC to complete this requirement prior to entering Whitworth.
