ADMISSION APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants should send:
1. Completed and signed International Student Admission Application form and a copy of your passport.
 2. U.S. \$40 application fee. Pay by check or money order payable to: *Community Colleges of Spokane*. Payment also may be made by credit card.
 3. An original bank statement verifying funds in the amount of U.S. \$14,500 are available to cover educational and living expenses during attendance.
 4. An original or certified copy of official transcripts and degree result for high school, GED and colleges attended.* All transcripts must have an English translation. Submit transcripts for all U.S. transferable credits. High school graduation is required for admission to either SFCC or SCC regular academic programs.
- * Students who are planning to attend ESL **ONLY** are not required to submit the academic documents mentioned in item 4 above.

NO TOEFL SCORE IS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION TO EITHER SFCC OR SCC.

- Students applying for admission to the academic program at **SFCC** must have a TOEFL score of 500 (paper-based), 173 (CBT) or 61 (IBT).
- Students applying for admission to the academic program at **SCC** must have a TOEFL score of 470 (paper-based), 150 (CBT) or 52 (IBT).
- Students without a TOEFL score, or with a TOEFL score under the requirements indicated above, are enrolled in SFCC's Intensive English Language Program (ESL) and are guaranteed admission to either SFCC or SCC upon successful completion of the ESL language program.
