1. We agree with the principles, practices, and procedures for entering into and changing articulation agreements as set forth in the document “*Articulation Agreement*.”
2. We have evaluated respective individual and course competencies and have determined that the Spokane Skills Center students who successfully complete the competencies identified in the document titled “*Articulation Agreement*” is eligible for special consideration. A Spokane Skills Center student must:
 - Have appropriate SAT or ASSET scores for admission to the program.*
 - Complete the Nursing Assistant Certificate program at the Spokane Skills Center with a grade of 2.0 or above in each course.
 - Complete the first two quarters of the Vision Care Specialist program at Spokane Community College with a grade of 2.0 or above in each course.

Students may apply for admission to the Vision Care Specialist program during the open admission period beginning December 1 of the year prior to the fall quarter that admission is desired. Five percent of the spaces in the fall class are reserved for Spokane Skills Center students. When more students wish to articulate, the remaining applicants will be considered with the entire applicant pool and may not be selected for fall admission.

*Students with lower scores will be admitted to the college and asked to take courses that will support college success. This may delay admission to the selected vocational program. The ASSET test is given at Spokane Community College and Spokane Falls Community College. There is a \$10 charge for the test.
