



Spokane Community College PACE Services / SEER STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

A college must maintain conditions conducive to the effective performance of its functions. Consequently, this class, as part of the college, has special expectations regarding the conduct of its students. Student conduct which distracts from or interferes with accomplishment of PACE Services' goals is not acceptable.

Admission to PACE Services / SEER carries with it the presumption that students will conduct themselves as responsible members of the academic community. This includes an expectation that students will obey the law, will comply with rules and regulations of the college and its departments, will maintain a high standard of integrity and honesty, and will respect the rights, privileges and property of other members of the class and college community.

It is assumed that students are, and wish to be treated as, adults. As such, students will accept responsibility for their own conduct and actions.

STUDENTS ENROLLED IN PACE SERVICES / SEER ARE EXPECTED TO FOLLOW THESE RULES:

- **No smoking, except in designated areas**
- **No consumption or under the influence of liquor or marijuana**
- **No possession or under the influence of illegal drugs or marijuana**
- **No possession of firearms or weapons of any kind**
- **No misconduct or disruption of any college class**
- **No theft or damage of college or other students' property**
- **No violation of any federal, state or local law**
- **No abusive behavior or language to any person**
- **No violence, harassment or intimidation to any person**
- **No misconduct at college functions**
- **No stalking of another person**
- **No reckless endangerment to others or property**
- **No assaultive behavior**
- **No abuse or theft of CCS information technology**
- **No academic dishonesty**
- **No hazing**
- **No sexual misconduct**
- **Do not discriminate**
- **No trespassing**
- **Comply with college officials**
