Designated Transfer Degree

- Associate of Arts
- Associate of Science, Option I
- Associate of Science, Option II

This designated degree will transfer as a block of 90-credits to Evergreen. Applicants who have earned, or who will earn, this degree prior to entering Evergreen are awarded the highest admission preference.

Acceptable Upside Down Degrees

- Natural Resources
 - Forestry
 - Parks & Recreation
 - Soils
 - Wildlife
- Water Resources

An Upside Down Degree may transfer to Evergreen as a block of 90-credits after the student has completed 90 Evergreen credits. You are eligible for the Upside Down Degree Program if you meet the following criteria:

- You have earned an approved technical degree listed above
- You have successfully completed college-level English composition (ENG 101) or equivalent with a 2.0 grade or better
- You have a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or better
