State Funding Support

The average cost of educating a resident full-time student for a year is \$7,041 (*9). A 12-credit resident student at CCS pays \$2,615 in tuition. The remaining \$4,426 is paid for by the state of Washington.

*2 Residency status is waived for refugee (23), congressional dependents (52), high school residency (20), international student exchange (38), and higher education employees (half-time or more) and spouses and dependents living in Washington State (24). Resident tuition applies.
