**Notes:**

1. Parking permits are available for purchase from the campus cashier's office.
2. A vehicle must be registered to purchase a CCS parking permit.
  - a. A vehicle license plate number is required for registration.
  - b. Parking permits are not transferable to other individuals but may be transferred to another vehicle owned and operated by the purchaser of the permit.
3. Guest permits are available from designated building administrative offices. Guests and visitors are given a reasonable time to secure a temporary guest permit.
4. Parking permits are the property of CCS and may be recalled by the appropriate vice president or designee for any of the following reasons:
  - a. When the purpose for which the permit was issued changes or no longer exists; or
  - b. When a permit is used for an unregistered vehicle or by an unauthorized individual; or
  - c. Falsification on a parking permit application; or
  - d. Continued violations of parking regulations; or
  - e. Counterfeiting or altering a parking permit.
